(1) Wapato Lake Campground

353 E. Wapato Lake Road.
26 RV sites and 14 tent sites, RV dump station, fishing, restrooms and showers.

(2) Old Mill Park

Hwy 150 and E. Wapato Lake Road.
4-lane boat launch, short term moorage, picnic area, restrooms, marine dump station, boat trailer parking. 20 acres.
Launch/Park, \$7.00 daily.
(7 day maximum at any time).
Annual launch permits available.

(3) Manson Bay Park

Downtown Manson.
Lake overview, swimming, picnic area, restrooms, winter only boat launch.
6 acres.

(4) Singleton Park

Madeline Road and Hyacinth.
4-baseball fields, soccer field, basketball court, restrooms, playground, gazebo with BBQ pits for picnics.
10 acres

(5) Willow Point Park

Lakeshore Drive to Willow Point Road.
Day use park with picnic tables, swimming, boating and playgrounds.
(chemical toilets)

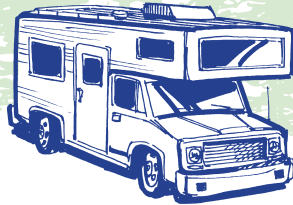

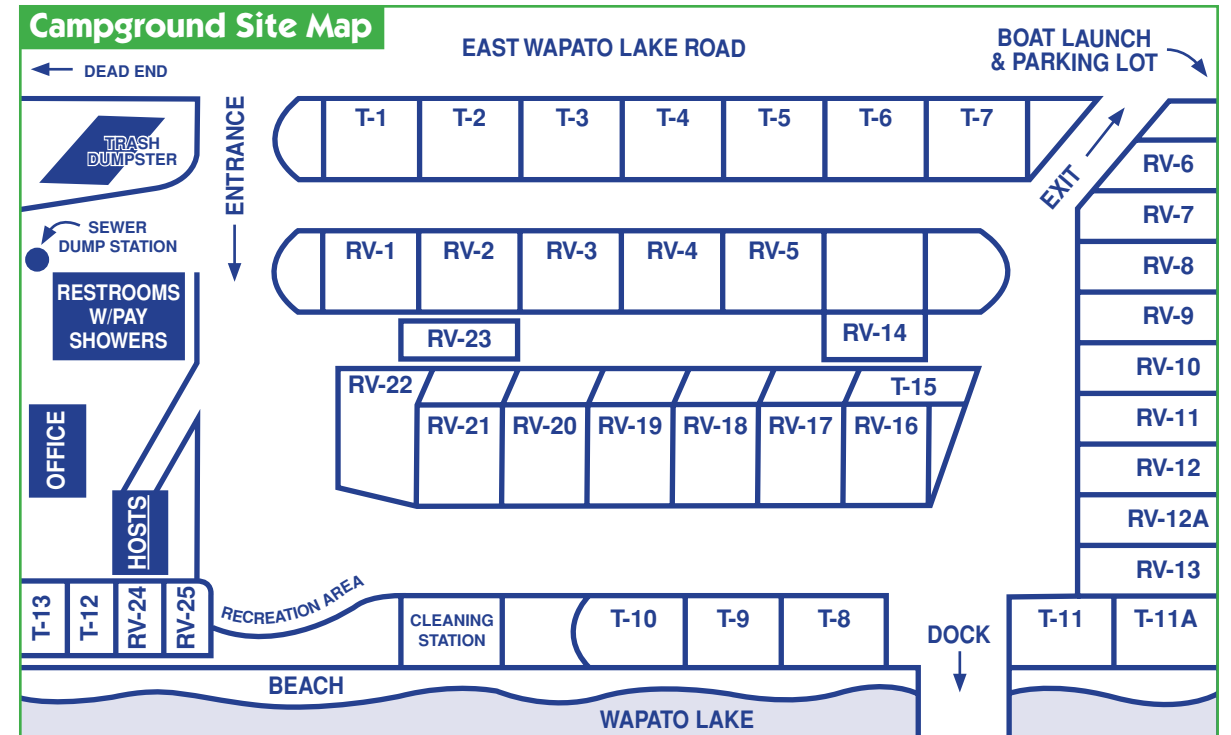
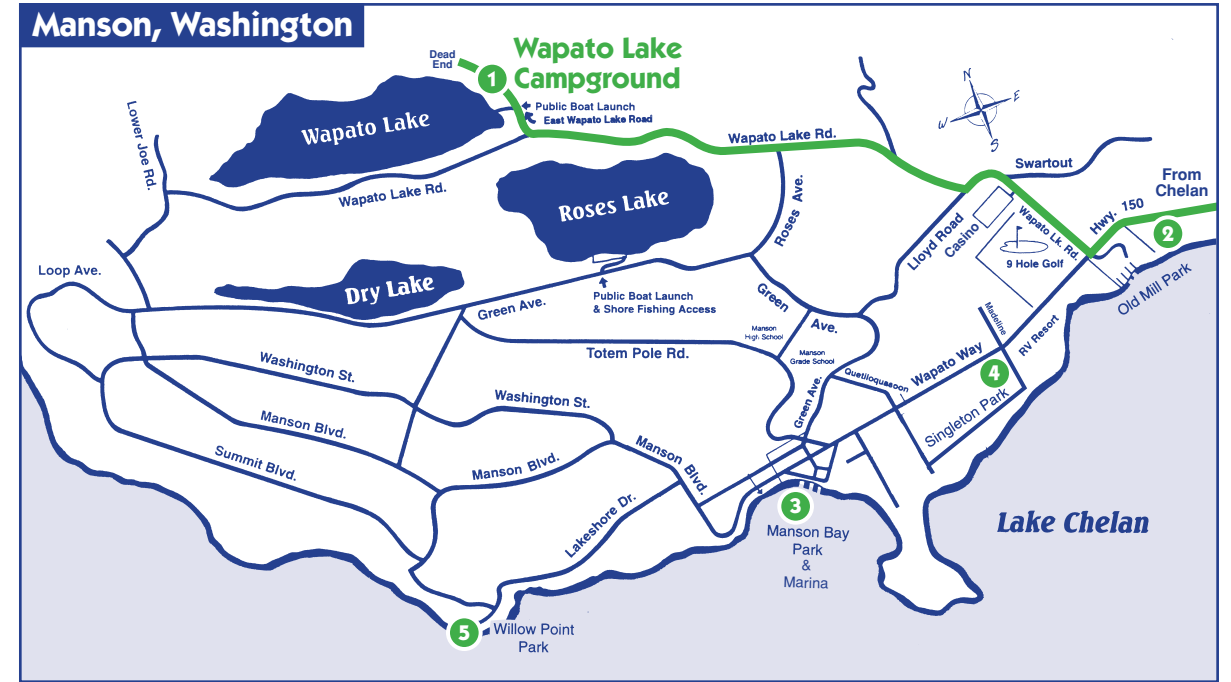

Rates

Subject to change without notice

RV sites w/50amps are \$30/night.* All other RV sites are \$25/night.* Tent sites are \$22/night.* - This fee includes 1 RV or 1 tent on one site with one vehicle and four people. An extra vehicle is \$6.00 per night.

Some of the RV sites will accommodate a tent on the same site with the RV. However, added fees apply. Additional vehicles, people, tents, etc. on the same site may be subject to an additional charge to be determined at a later date. Children under four years old may camp for free.

When making multiple reservations for the same date, a separate name must be on each site, and whoever makes the reservations will pay for all sites at the time of the reservation.

Park Information

RESERVATIONS

Require advance payment in full plus a \$5.00 non-refundable administrative fee per site. Reservations are accepted all year. It then must be in advance by VISA or MC. **ANY CHANGES IN RESERVATIONS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL COST \$10 PER SITE. NO ADDITIONAL GUESTS, VEHICLES OR TENTS WILL BE ALLOWED.**

From April 15 through Sept 15 the campground office will be open. To make your reservations, call 509-687-6037. Sept 16 through April 14 you can make reservations by calling the Parks Office at 509-687-9536. **WE ACCEPT VISA & MC CREDIT/DEBIT CARDS.**

YOUR LENGTH OF STAY SHALL NOT EXCEED 10 CONSECUTIVE DAYS. You must leave the campground for at least 2 days, then you may return. This gives us ample time to do heavy watering and maintenance to the site.

CANCELLATION POLICY

Requires 10 days notice to be given prior to your arrival date. Please e-mail us at wlc@mansonparks.com. We will gladly refund your payment minus the \$5 non-refundable administrative fee and a **\$10 cancellation fee**. Less than 10 days before your arrival, or once you have checked into the campground, **NO REFUNDS** will be given for early departures or cancellations.

- * **Weekend reservations require a 2 night stay.**

CANCELLATION POLICY CONTINUED

The campground also reserves the right to rent the reserved space to new campers if you check out before the expiration of your time. No subletting of a site will be permitted. If you have a problem on the road or are going to be late, please call us at 509-687-6037. **PLEASE** leave a **MESSAGE STATING YOUR ETA**. Messages are checked frequently. If we don't hear from you, we can only hold your reservation for 6 hours past the check-in time, which would be 8 PM. If you don't show up or call us by 8 PM, you will be declared a NO-SHOW and your site and payment will be forfeited.

CHECK IN

 time is 2:00 p.m.

Please have your confirmation with you and register at the park office. Each vehicle may be required to have a car pass displayed on the mirror. Your vehicle pass will be given to you upon check-in. For those of you who check in before 2 PM, please be aware that you do so at your own risk, as we perform maintenance and watering during this time.

CHECK OUT

 time is 12:00 (NOON)

Please make sure your site is promptly cleared by noon, so we can get ready for new arrivals. Those who do not check out by noon may be subject to an additional night's fee and loss of your site. Please check with the park office if you desire to stay later than noon. We can check to see if it is feasible.

ALL VEHICLES AND PEOPLE must be registered at the park office upon arrival. You are responsible for your guests and their actions. **QUIET TIMES ARE 10 PM-8 AM**. Please think of your neighbors. No vehicle stereos.

THERE IS A 3-NIGHT MINIMUM STAY REQUIRED FOR MAJOR HOLIDAYS, SUCH AS MEMORIAL DAY, FOURTH OF JULY AND LABOR DAY WEEKENDS WITH FULL PAYMENT REQUIRED, PLUS \$5.00 NON-REFUNDABLE FEE.

NO BOATS OR BOAT TRAILERS ARE ALLOWED IN THE CAMPGROUND AT ANY TIME. You are, however, welcome to drive through the campground with them, to stop and unload your camping gear, then **PROMPTLY**, remove them from the campground. There is ample parking in the boat launch parking lot adjacent to our campground. OR you may launch your boat and tie it to the dock. Our docks are on a first come basis. They may not be reserved.

DO NOT move the picnic tables from their current location! **PLEASE**.

We do not have sewer hook-ups on the sites. However, we do have a sewer dump station in the campground. Some of our RV sites have 50 amp power and some have 30 amp. And a few have only 110. For this reason, your site assignment is not guaranteed. It all depends on the size of your RV, availability, length of stay, etc. You will HAVE a site, but it may not be the one you requested or were first assigned. There will be no RV's in the tent sites. No more than 2 tents per tent site, and 1 RV per RV site.

DO NOT drink from or connect to any **RED** water faucets as they are **NOT** potable water. It is irrigation coming from the lake.

RESTROOM USAGE

Restrooms are available for your comfort.

Restroom rules:

- No Smoking
- No Alcohol Consumption
- No Glass Containers
- No Pets
- No Bikes, Scooters, Skateboards
in Restrooms or other Walkways
- No Washing Dishes
- No Household Garbage
(a dumpster is provided for your convenience)
- No Bare Feet

Restrooms have showers available for a minimal fee for your convenience.

PETS

All dogs need to be leashed at all times. Pets must be taken outside the park for potty breaks, and also must be cleaned up after. Please no Pit Bulls or Rottweiler mixes.

THE EQUIPMENT, APPARATUS, AND FACILITIES ARE FURNISHED SOLELY FOR THE CONVENIENCE OF OUR GUESTS, AND ALL PERSONS USING THE SAME, DO SO AT THEIR OWN RISK. THE MANSON PARKS DISTRICT, WAPATO LAKE CAMPGROUND OR ANY MANAGEMENT WILL NOT BE HELD RESPONSIBLE FOR ACCIDENTS, INJURIES, OR LOSS OF PROPERTY BY FIRE, THEFT, WIND, OR ANY ACT OF GOD OR NATURE.

SPEED LIMITS IN THE CAMPGROUND ARE 5 MILES PER HOUR.

THERE ARE NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY AT ANY TIME!!!!

ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES ARE PERMITTED WITHIN YOUR DESIGNATED CAMPSITE ONLY, FOR GUESTS OVER 21, EXCEPT ON MEMORIAL DAY WEEKEND.

NO GLASS CONTAINERS ALLOWED ON DOCKS OR NEAR THE LAKE.

CAMPFIRES ARE ALLOWED DURING CERTAIN TIMES IN DESIGNATED CEMENT OR METAL FIRE RINGS ONLY.

Rock pits are not acceptable, so please do not make them in your site. Tents and inflatables are allowed on the grass, but must be removed daily by 10 AM and may not be set up again until 6 PM each day, as requested by the park hosts. All mats and rugs must be kept off the grass at ALL TIMES. No tarps are allowed under tents. This is to prevent grass kill. For the enjoyment of all, sites must be kept free of litter and in a neat and orderly fashion. Please keep all personal items confined to your assigned site area.

NO PARKING ON THE GRASS AT ANY TIME, FOR ANY REASON!!!!

CLOTHES AND TENT LINES, SPORTS NETS AND AWNINGS ARE NOT to be attached to trees, fences or electrical and water standards. All sports nets must be removed when not in use.

NO WASHING OF BOATS, RV's OR VEHICLES ALLOWED IN THE PARK.

VIOLATION OF PARK POLICIES may result in loss of site and forfeiture of any applicable fees. No person shall indulge in offensive, profane, or threatening or indecent conduct or language.
